REGISTER OF MEMBERS' INTERESTS

Updated: 6 April 2022

Guidance Note for Members

1. Completing the Register

- Under The Local Government Act 2000 (as amended), the Monitoring Officer is required to establish and maintain a Register of Members' Interests.
- The Local Government (Democracy) (Wales) Act 2013 extended the reference to Monitoring Officer to include the Proper Officer of a Town/Community Council.
- Paragraph 15 of the Code of Conduct adopted by Ceredigion County Council on 21 April 2016, (effective from 20 May 2016), requires Members and co-opted members of Ceredigion County Council, and Town/Community Councils in Ceredigion to register in the Register of Members' Interests any interests which fall within a category mentioned in paragraph 10(2)(a) of the Code of Conduct. This can be done by providing written notification to the County Council's Monitoring Officer; or, in the case of a Town/ Community Council with that authority's Proper Officer.
- Each Member has been given an individual Register like this one to complete and return. The Monitoring Officer keeps these together to form the statutory **Register of Members' Interests.** Each Register can be updated as necessary or separate forms can be completed by Members and inserted into the Register.
- The categories of interests mentioned in paragraph 10(2)(a) of the Code are set out on pages 5 7.
 Members are required to register any interests which fall within these categories by inserting details in the space provided (pages 9-14). Paragraph 10(2)(a)(vi) of the Code of Conduct: identifying the road will suffice. Members who have no such interests should write 'none' in the space provided.

2. Upon Election

 This Register must be completed and returned to the Monitoring Officer within 28 days of your Authority's Code of Conduct being adopted or the mandatory provisions of this model code being applied to your authority; or, your election or appointment to office, whichever is the latest.

3. During your term of office

Notifying the Monitoring Officer of any new interests

You must, within 28 days of becoming aware of any new personal interest falling within a category mentioned in paragraph 10(2)(a) register that new interest in your authority's Register of Members' Interests by providing written notification to the County Council's Monitoring Officer. You must also complete an annual return (in April each year).

• Notifying the Monitoring Officer or Proper Officer of any changes

You must, within 28 days of becoming aware of any new personal interest or a change to any personal interest which has already been registered, register that new personal interest or change by providing written notification to your authority's Monitoring Officer, or in the case of a community council to your authority's Proper Officer.

Notifying the Monitoring Officer of a personal interest in accordance with Paragraph 11 for the first time

You must, when disclosing a personal interest in accordance with paragraph 11 for the first time, register that personal interest in your authority's register of Members' Interests by providing written notification to your authority's Monitoring Officer, or in the case of a Town/ Community council to your authority's Proper Officer.

Notifying the Monitoring Officer of any interests disclosed during meetings

When you disclose an interest orally at a meeting of the Authority, you must, before or immediately after the meeting, give written notification to the Monitoring Officer by completing the appropriate form, copies of which will be available at meetings.

You must disclose an interest each time it arises but you only need to give written notification to the Monitoring Officer (or Proper Officer) *once*.

Members should be aware that the Local Government (Democracy) (Wales) Act 2013 requires the County Council to publish the Register of Members' interests.

11	(1) Where you have a personal interest in any business of your authority and you attend a meeting at which that business is considered, you must disclose orally to that meeting the existence and nature of that interest before or at the commencement of that consideration, or when the interest becomes apparent.
	 (2) Where you have a personal interest in any business of your authority and you make — (a) written representations (whether by letter, facsimile or some other form of electronic communication) to a member or officer of your authority regarding that business, you should include details of that interest in the written communication; or (b) oral representations (whether in person or some form of electronic communication) to a member or officer of your authority you should disclose the interest at the commencement of such representations, or when it becomes apparent to you that you have such an interest, and confirm the representation and interest in writing within 14 days of the representation.
	(3) Subject to paragraph 14(1)(b) below, where you have a personal interest in any business of your authority and you have made a decision in exercising a function of an executive or board, you must in relation to that business ensure that any written statement of that decision records the existence and nature of your interest.
	(4) You must, in respect of a personal interest not previously disclosed, before or immediately after the close of a meeting where the disclosure is made pursuant to sub-paragraph 11(1), give written notification to your authority in accordance with any requirements identified by your authority's monitoring officer or in relation to a community council, your authority's proper officer from time to time but, as a minimum containing - (a) details of the personal interest; (b) details of the business to which the personal interest relates; and (c) your signature.
	(5) Where you have agreement from your monitoring officer that the information relating to your personal interest is sensitive information, pursuant to paragraph 16(1), your obligations under this paragraph 11 to disclose such information, whether orally or in writing, are to be replaced with an obligation to disclose the existence of a personal interest and to confirm that your monitoring officer has agreed that the nature of such personal interest is sensitive information.
	(6) For the purposes of sub-paragraph (4), a personal interest will only be

- deemed to have been previously disclosed if written notification has been provided in accordance with this code since the last date on which you were elected, appointed or nominated as a member of your authority.
- (7) For the purposes of sub-paragraph (3), where no written notice is provided in accordance with that paragraph you will be deemed as not to have declared a personal interest in accordance with this code.
